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Introduction

The 2025-26 Supplementary Estimates No. 1 are prepared in accordance with subsection 12(1) of *The Financial Administration Act, 1993* and include the estimated increase in 2025-26 “To Be Voted” and “Statutory” expenditures, loans, advances or investments to be paid from the General Revenue Fund (GRF).

Funding requests reflect the additional commitments government has undertaken during the fiscal year. The requested funding for each vote is the net amount required after reallocation of voted appropriation not required in other areas of the vote.

The schedules contained in the 2025-26 Supplementary Estimates No. 1 use a similar format to those included in the 2025-26 Estimates.

The subvote descriptions provided in the 2025-26 Estimates apply to the 2025-26 Supplementary Estimates No. 1; however, subvote descriptions may be expanded by the explanation for the additional funding provided by supplementary estimates within the fiscal year.

The *General Principles, Budget and Spending Control, Budget Principles* and *Glossary of Terms* outlined in the 2025-26 Estimates apply to the 2025-26 Supplementary Estimates No. 1.
